Can you tell me more about the program:

The Michigan Court Administrators Association has partnered with the National Center for State Courts, Institute for Court Management to bring the Certified Court Manager's program to Michigan's Court Leaders. The goal of the program is to educate and build relationships amongst our state's court professionals.

The program consists of six, 2.5 day classes that must be fully completed in order to earn certification.

Cohorts of approximately 50 students complete the classes at the Hall of Justice over the course of two years.
